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Anna-Karin Andersson is one of the younger generation of folk musicians who has established herself on the Nordic folk music scene. Her incredible way of playing the hardanger fiddle with rythms, frasing, and brilliance, together with a raw and heavy fiddle sound, takes the listener to another world. With great passion and a big confidence she now releases her first solo album where she combines traditional Norwegian folk tunes with her own compositions.

— I became completely enchanted by Norwegian folk music as a student back in the days, and since then I've explored folk music from Norway, and especially hardanger fiddle music from Setesdal. A passion that will probably never end. With the album Gränsland I explore the borderland between Swedish and Norwegian folk music, between tradition and composition, and within myself as an artist. Releasing traditional material together with my own tunes becomes my way of challenging old structures, traditions, boundaries, and the idea of what tradition really is. With Gränsland I want to stretch the artistic boundaries of what Norwegian folk music is, and who has the right to play it, says Anna-Karin.
